
RE: State Certification of Residential Building Energy Codes

Dear Mr. Risser:

In compliance with Title III of the Energy Conservation and Production Act (ECPA) of 1976, as amended, this is to certify that the State of Oregon has adopted the 2011 Oregon Residential Energy Efficiency Specialty Code with energy provisions that meet or exceed applicable requirements of the 2012 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) for low-rise residential buildings. Enclosed please find a copy of the Oregon Secretary of State's Permanent Rule Filing, dated May 12, 2011, which includes adoption of the Oregon Residential Specialty Code (ORSC). The code was advertised and a public hearing was held. The ORSC became effective on July 1, 2011.
